



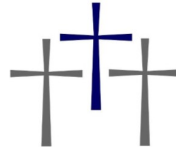

MORTGAGE

Covenant is 14 years into its repayment of a building expansion and renovation loan with a projected year-end balance of about \$370,000.

Our current mortgage places a \$70,000 burden on our annual operating budget. Eliminating this burden will free up additional funds for mission and ministry.

SANCTUARY HEATING AND AIR

Our sanctuary HVAC system can no longer be used responsibly. It is inefficient, expensive to maintain, and ecologically unsound. We estimate a cost of \$194,000 to replace it. We have \$134,000 cash on hand and need an additional \$60,000 to fully fund this project.

ROOFING

When it rains, it pours, and that's particularly problematic when it occurs indoors. Several areas of roofing need repair or replacement with an estimated cost of \$67,000.
